Each ping pong ball will have a letter written on it. We will sing our letter song about each letter that is picked and children will be asked to name words that begin with each letter and sound. They will also practice writing each letter on their boards. (Children in school will match lower case to uppercase letters by placing each correct ping pong ball with lower case letter into the correct matching cup with uppercase letter.)

# Aluminum Foil and Paper Balls

Teacher will make one ball with aluminum foil and one ball with paper and pass them around for the children to feel. Teacher will then ask, "Which ball do you think will go the farthest when thrown?" Teacher will "tally" children's predictions and then test them by throwing both balls. We will then look and measure how far each ball went and discuss results. Children will be asked why they think this happened. Children will be encouraged to try this experiment on their own both at home and at school.

Children will solve riddles while learning vocabulary related to basketball.

## Special Activity

### Line up the Balls

Gather a collection of different balls (if your child has a variety) and have your child put them in order from the smallest to the biggest. (If you do not have at least 4 or 5 balls, you can cut out 5 different sized circles to represent the balls and have your child line the circles up from the smallest to the biggest.

# Morning Meeting

## Solid or Hollow Ramp Experiment

We will roll a solid ball and a hollow ball down a slanted surface or ramp to see what happens. Teacher will ask, "What do you think will happen? Which ball do you think will travel faster down the ramp? We will then roll a solid cylinder (wood block cylinder) and a hollow cylinder (Paper towel tube) down the ramp and discuss results.
